3. School calendar presentation

Heather presented the power point presentation and explained the PL opportunities. She explained that she presented the presentation to the staff on Tuesday, March 18/25.

Heather opened the floor for any questions. These days would be targeted towards improving our school SIP and overall school data. - 4. SIP Update
  - a. Heather shared our SIP goals for literacy. We have broken down our literacy goals K-2, 3-5, 6-8. We are building on each grade from K-8.
  - b. When we look at the DIP goal that everyone graduates, we have been looking at ways of gathering data of absenteeism and are shifting our focus in May. We will look at career connections and develop personal connections and pathways.

Through our surveys about asking students if they want to graduate from high school and what their plan is for after high school.

- 5. Provincial assessment dates Heather sent out the provincial dates in the March newsletter to parents. Heather discussed the difference from this year's calendar and last. She pointed out that there is much shorter time span.
- 6. Levels of Language Learners Sandra presented the stats on Magnetic Hills MLL learners in the building and the supports that they are receiving. A brief overview of the LLJD documents, A1 to B2 levels, and examples of the need for vocabulary development.
- 7. Leveled readers and decodable text Sandra gave a synopsis of the meeting the 1 3 immersion teachers had with EECD. Magnetic Hill purchased a number of decodable text to help with teacher reading tables.
